

# Safety

# Installation

Can be installed and operated in any orientation except permanently inverted.

#### Handles

Batteries must not be suspended by their handles (where fitted).

#### **Vent valves**

Each cell is fitted with a low pressure release valve to allow gasses to escape and then reseal.

#### Gas release

VRLA batteries release hydrogen gas which can form explosive mixtures in the air. Do not place inside a sealed container.

### Recycling

YUASA's VRLA batteries must be recycled at the end of life in accordance with local and national laws and regulations.
